815 PRIME LAMBS

The weekly sale of prime lambs had an increased entry of 815 forward meeting plenty of demand from a busy ring of buyers. There was plenty of variety on offer in Hawes on offer in the prime lamb ring at Hawes with a third of the entry being mules and pet lambs with an overall market average of 295p/kg. well fleshed continental lambs easily selling in excess of the 300p/kg. Well fleshed heavy weighted lambs in strong demand with more required each week to fill the requirements of the buyers.

The consignment from JR & LA Capstick, Killington lead the way selling to a top of £170 with a 50kg Beltex lamb purchased by C Steadman Butchers, Kirkby Stephen. From the same good home 49kg Beltex sold to £167 purchased by Westmorland Tebay Services with other Beltex lambs from same home sold to £161 and £160. Texel lambs from HJ Thwaite, Hawes sold to a top of £166 for 52kg lambs. Other leading prices saw Beltex lambs to £165 from R Mudd & Sons, Cubeck, Texel lambs to £159 at R Moore & Son, Texel lambs at £158 from C & M Hugill and £158 from DL Mudd. Better conformation Beltex lambs sold in excess of the 340 pence per kilo mark. All Beltex lambs forward averaged £146.18.

Suffolk lambs topped at £166 at 48kg from JR & LA Capstick purchased by Westmorland Tebay Services. Plenty of pens of heavy weight lambs sold in the region of £150 and in excess. Other headline prices for heavy weighted Suffolks sold to £155 from DA & MA Brown & Son at 48kg followed by £154 for 49kg Suffolks from Stephen Alderson.

Mule lambs sold to a top of £144 for a pen of 21 lambs at 49kg from WA & A Booth followed by heavy weight mules to £140 from B Bell & Son and DJ Amsden. The consignment from P Hallam sold 46kg Mules to £131.50 and £130.50 with 45kg mules to £128.50. Masham lambs sold to £129 at 44kg from CT & JE Willoughby.

Beltex were headed by R Marwood & Son at £182 followed closely by BC Gregg again with 2 lots at £180. Masham made £176 from LC Scarr & Son and mules topped at £166 but very consistent and 10 lots were between £152-£166 and even leaner ones between £130-£145. 288 swales forward and were very keenly bid for topping at a whopping £130 for G Harker & Son. With 10 lots from £110-£130, medium ewes were nicely selling for between £60-£85 and even the leaner ewes up again selling for £40-£50. Grazing men now looking to buy but clipped ewes are required. 12 Rams forward with Suffolks selling to £168 and Swaledales to £132.
