PRIME LAMBS

There was a larger entry of prime lambs greeted with a returning buyer. The entry of lambs was very mixed with heavy weight well fleshed lambs and good conformation lambs a respectable trade with a number of lambs forward today lean and requiring further feeding which were financially penalised in the prime ring today. Heavy weighted well finished lambs were keenly sought after and keen competition from buyers today to purchase them. Topping the market today was the consignment from JR & LA Capstick, Killington selling 54kg Texel lambs to £172 with 48kg Texel lambs from the same home selling to £160 both purchased by C Steadman Butchers, Kirkby Stephen. Leading prices for heavy weight texels was £167 from Whyte & Percival, Bainbridge, £162 and £160 from J Scarr & Sons, Askrigg and at £160 was G Harker & Son, Arkengarthdale with plenty more pens selling in the one hundred and fifties.

Beltex lambs were keenly sought after selling to a market average of 3.06p/kg. They sold to a top of 345p/kg for the consignment from R Mudd & Son, Cubeck who sold two pens at £140. Beltex lambs sold to a top of £165 from JW & JH Burton & Son who sold others to £157.

A cracking run of Suffolk lambs from L Bosomworth, Northallerton who has a consignment of Suffolk rams for the Hawes Hunks on Thursday evening. They sold a pen of 27 lambs at 51kg to £147 with a pen of 23 lambs at 48kg selling to £139.50.

A bumper entry of well over 500 mule lambs forward today. Well fleshed and mule lambs with weight saw eager bidding with grass mules in the early forty kilograms harder to place. Heavy weight mules sold to a top of £141 from J Scarr & Sons, with other pens of heavy weighted mules selling in excess of the one hundred and thirty marks.

There are more horned and hill lambs in today saw Gritstone lambs from JE Cowperthwaite sell to £125. Cheviot lambs sold to £122 from WA Dinsdale & Son. Swaledale lambs sold to a top of £100 from Bainbridge Bros, Marrick. There was an overall market average of 261p/kg to include a broad spectrum of lamb's weights.
