#### PRIME LAMBS

The trade for prime lambs a penny or two sharper than the previous week. Well fleshed lambs with weight continue to be the best to sell and met with eager bidding from the buyers. The overall market average was 264p/kg with lambs weighing over the 45kg mark averaging in excess of the 270p/kg mark. Heavy weight lambs topped the market selling to £168 with 58kg texels from T & LM Goad & Sons, Dent. This was followed by heavy weight Texels from J Scarr & Sons, Askrigg selling to £164, the consignment from A Lodge, Malham Moor selling to £164, £150 and £147. Other leading prices for heavy continental lambs saw J & S Mitchell, Sedbergh to £158, £157 from B Clarkson, Bainbridge with others to £156 from JR & LA Capstick, Killington. Plenty of pens sold in the one hundred and forties. Heavy weight Suffolks sold to £149 from J & J Postlethwaite, Howgill. Heavy weight mule lambs sold to £140 from JW & JH Burton, Gayle, followed by £139 from A Lodge, Malham Moor. Mule wether lambs weighing between 45-48kg regularly selling between 255p/kg and 265p/kg. The better conformation Beltex and continental lambs continue to sell in the region of 300p/kg selling to a top of 321p/kg from JW & JH Burton, Gayle.

Cheviots were tidy trade with 4 lots from £115-£122 for fit ewes. 90 Mules forward they topped at £120 from A & TA Blades and most lots were either side of £100. 240 swales and a better trade than last week with a few more medium fleshed than leaner about. Tops were £81 from J & S Mitchell followed by JS & D Cloughton and K Hulley at £74 with plenty of lots between £50-£60. 9 Rams forward topped at £230 for Cleaboy Farms and £152 from R Wood & Son.
