### LIVESTOCK MARKET REPORT

#### TUESDAY 11<sup>TH</sup> JUNE 2024

Forward: 9 Calves and 1056 Sheep comprising 202 Spring Lambs, 258 Prime Hoggs and 596 Cast Ewes and Rams.

#### PRIME LAMBS

The weekly sale of prime lambs saw an increased entry over 200 forward selling to a strong market average of 405p/kg with an SQQ average of 407p/kg in which more lambs easily could have been sold to the advantage of vendors. The sale included the early summer show of pairs of prime lambs. Thank you goes to sale day sponsors Horner Shearing and WH Harker and a special mention to James Birbeck who we thank for his time and expertise judging the show.

The championship rosette was awarded to the first prize pair of Suffolk lambs from WM Avison & Son, Leyburn weighing 47kg and selling to £230 purchased by James Birbeck on behalf of C Steadman & Son Butchers Kirkby Stephen. The reserve champion rosette was awarded to the first prized pair of continental sired lambs from JR & LA Capstick, Killington, this smart pair of Beltex lambs weighed 45kg sold to £225 or 500p/kg purchased by M Hare of Lane End Farm Shop Tong.

Texel lambs from Sledmere Estate sold to £208 with heavy weight lambs. The consignment of Texel lambs from JR & LA Capstick sold to £201, £198 twice with the consignment averaging 45kg selling to £195.33 or 428p/kg. This was followed by the consignment from WM Avison & Son, Leyburn selling pens of Suffolk lambs to £195 and Texels to the same price with this consignment averaging 44kg selling to an average of £191.86 or 434p/kg. Pens of well fleshed spring lambs regularly selling in the region of £180. More mule lambs now starting to come forward saw the consignment from DJ Amsden selling 43kg lambs to £166 and 40kg lambs to £155.

Texel x ewes topped at £228 from JR & LA Capstick, Killington followed by £220 from P & JM Hutchinson. Leading the Suffolk trade was three lots from WN Avison selling to £195 and £192 twice. Mules topped at £178 from S & A Bland. An excellent run of 49 mule ewes from A Flintoff, Robin Hoods Bay selling to £174 and £168 with nine pens selling between 166 and £178. A large quantity of horned ewes forward. Swaledale saw the full variety forward from very lean to good ewes. Lean ewes sold between £30 and £50, mediums £55 to £80 with best fleshed Swaledale ewes selling between £90 and £125 peaking at £130 from S Bell & Son. Rough Fells sold to a top of £148 & £146 from S & A Bland. There wasn't a big entry of tups forward but were eagerly bid for.
