The reserve championship was awarded to the first prize pen of five Suffolk sired lambs from JR & LA Capstick, Killington at 47kg went onto sell for £158 from JR & LA Capstick, Killington purchased by the judge Dave Morland. The consignment of Beltex lambs from WN Avison & Son, Leyburn sold to a top of £165 at 48kg. Leading prices for heavy weighted lambs saw Suffolks sell to £156 from R & R Gornall, Sedbergh followed by £154 for 50kg Texels from Matt Alderson and £153 from Bainbridge Bros, Marrick and N White, Marrick followed by £150 from DA & MA Brown & Son, Leyburn and BC Gregg, Masham with plenty more pens selling in the late one hundred and forties.

398 forward and trade just slightly less than last week and buyers preferring clipped ewes especially the Swaledales. Texels from WN Avison & Son topped trade at £180 & £178 and a further 7 lots were £140 plus. Suffolks peaked at £175 & £162. Mules a good level trade topped at £142 from J &JH Whaley and were regularly above £120 mark with 10 lots between £122-£142. Roughfell sold to £125 for a cracking pen of 13 ewes from E & K Bland. Swaledales similar trade to last week for the top stronger sorts peaking at £108 from JC & N Throup with 9 lots between £84-£108. Leaner freshly spained would be slightly cheaper between £30-£55 and with grazing men starting look clipped ewes would be to an advantage. Rams only a few forward and they topped at £160 for shearling Cheviot from RJ Lund and Swaledales to £108 from JS & S Atkinson.
