The weekly sale of prime lambs saw the trade sell to a top of £182 for a smart conformation 48kg Beltex lamb from JR & LA Capstick purchased by C Steadman Butchers Kirkby Stephen. Heavy weight lambs sold to £174 for Texels from C & M Hugill, £170 from A Lodge and £170 from R Mudd & Sons. Handy weighted better conformation lambs sold to £167 from WM Avison & Son, £166 from R Mudd & Sons followed by £165 from R Marwood & Son with plenty more selling in the region of the one hundred and sixty pound. Suffolk lambs sold to a top of £160 from JR & LA Capstick followed by £156 from WN Avison & Son and £154.50 from DA & MA Brown & Son. More upland bred lambs coming forward sold to a top of £144.50 for Lincoln Longwools from Sledmere Estate, Driffild whom sold Bluefaced Leicesters to £140. Mule lambs topped at £140 from DJ Amsden. The overall market average was 330p/kg.
