### 291 PRIME LAMBS

The weekly sale of prime lambs saw a smaller entry forward with less demand ringside as many outlets still busy with following the busy weekend for the festival. There was an overall market average of 358p/kg. Best quality lambs continue to sell in the region of 400p/kg topping at 405p/kg from WN Avison & Son, Leyburn for a pair of smart Beltex lambs. The market was topped at £193 for a Texel lamb from JR & LA Capstick, Killington who sold pens of Beltex lambs to £185 purchased C Steadman Butchers, Kirkby Stephen. Other pens of Texel lambs sold to £184 from Whyte & Percival, Bainbridge. Suffolk lambs sold to a top of £180 from JR & LA Capstick followed by other pens of Suffolk lambs to £179 from DA & MA Brown & Son, Leyburn. Mule lambs sold to £138 from DJ Amsden at 42kg followed by £137 for 41kg lambs from S Bell & Sons, Askrigg.
