PRIME LAMBS

The weekly sale of prime lambs saw the trade slightly easier than the previous week with the quality of lambs on offer more mixed. Once again well finished lambs with weight in most demand and keenest sought after. Leading the way was the consignment of heavy weight Texels from MR & LE Rukin, West Stonesdale selling to 56kg lambs to £168 and 54kg Texels to £160. Heavy weight Beltex lambs from JR & LA Capstick, Killington selling 55kg lambs to £165. Other leading prices for heavy weight Texels sold to £158 from A Lodge, Malham Moor, £156 from J Scarr & Sons, Askrigg and £155 from ME Dinsdale, Carperby with plenty more pens of heavy weight texels and continental lambs selling in the region of £150. Pens of better conformation Beltex type lambs sold in the region of 300p/kg.

Cheviot mule lambs sold to a top of £154 from DA & MA Brown & Son, Leyburn. Mule lambs topped at £150 for heavy weights from J Scarr & Sons, Askrigg followed by the consignment from E Fairburn & Sons, Thornton Steward selling to £145 and £142.50. other pens of heavy weight mules sold to £143.50 from SD Thompson, Aysgarth and £142.50 from A Lodge, Malham Moor. Plenty pens of mules sold in the one hundred and thirties. Pens of horned lambs to £100 for Swaledales from MR & LE Rukin, West Stonedale with two pens of Rough Fell Lambs to £100 from SL Hoggarth, Sedbergh.
