Forward: 1788 Sheep comprising 1486 Prime Lambs & 302 Cast Ewes & Rams.

1486 PRIME LAMBS

The weekly sale of Prime lambs enjoyed another buoyant trade at Hawes auction with another good entry of just shy of 1500 prime lambs forward. A good mix of all breeds of lambs forward selling to a market average of 279p/kg. Handy weighted continental lambs regularly selling in the region of 300p/kg and them export type lambs in demand. Better types of export lambs selling between 320p/kg and 340p/kg. heavy weighted lambs and mule lambs sold to a similar strong trade to the previous week. Horned lambs with meat same trade as previous week with leaner horned lambs not just as dear.

The sale was topped by heavy weighted Beltex lambs from Trevor Pounder, Bedale selling to £178, £166, £160 and £154. The texel trade topped at £178 for heavy weights from A Lodge, Malham Moor followed by other heavy weight Texels to £158 and £150 from JR Rukin, Keld followed by £153 and £149 from RS Harker & Son, Grayrigg. Plenty more pens of heavy weight continental lambs selling in the late one hundred and forties. Better conformation handy weighted Continental and Beltex lambs from K Milburn & A Devlin, Sedbergh selling to 340p/kg and 330p/kg with plenty selling between 320-330p/kg.

There was another good entry in the region of 700 mules forward keenly sought after with all mules forward selling to an average of £129.88. Heavy weight mules topped at £146 from T & LM Goad & Son, Dent. A ring full of 53kg Mules from RS Harker & Son, Grayrigg sold to £145 with 51kg mules from the same home selling to £141. At £145 were Mules from JR & LA Capstick, Killington. Mules at 51kg sold to £142 from J Scarr & Son, Askrigg, £141 from A Lodge, Malham Moor and £140 twice from J Garth & Son, Keasdon. Mule lambs at 50kg sold to £140 and £139 from WA & A Booth, Feizor. Mule lambs weighing in the mid forty kilo bracket selling the late one hundred and twenties to the early one hundred and thirties.

Cheviot lambs sold to £128 at 42kg from Shuttleworth & Brown, Sedbergh. Horned lambs sold to a top of £128 for 45kg Scottish Blackfaces from K Milburn & A Devlin, Sedbergh. Rough fell lambs sold to a top of £122 from SL Hoggarth. Swaledale lambs sold to a top of £114 from JW Porter & Sons, Gunnerside with plenty of other pens selling in the region of £110.
